To the Members of the House Federal and State Affairs Committee,

I urge you to vote no on the constitutional amendment HCR 5003 that denies the right to reproductive freedom in the Kansas Constitution.

I firmly believe that there should be a constitutional right to abortion. The decision to have an abortion is literally a life-altering one--I don't just mean for the possible child, but for the person who will undergo drastic physical, hormonal, financial, social, etc. changes as a result of pregnancy and birth--and that kind of decision should be made by the person considering an abortion, not the elected members of the legislature of the state of Kansas.
