Subject: **HB 2509; Expanding deferred retirement option program (DROP) membership to all KP&F members.**

House Bill No. 2509 amends the definition of "member" for the deferred retirement option program (DROP) within the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system (KP&F) to include any member of KP&F. Under current law, a member of DROP can only be a trooper, examiner or office of the Kansas highway patrol or an agent of the Kansas bureau of investigation.
