## **MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Bill Brief on SB 457

Senate Bill 457 requires a waiver of extradition proceedings as a condition of bond.

The bill amends K.S.A. 22-2802, the statute in the Kansas code of criminal procedure concerning release and the conditions of release prior to trial. The bill adds a new subsection (c) to provide that, in addition to any other conditions of release, the magistrate shall order a person to execute a waiver of extradition: (1) Stating that the person consents to extradition to Kansas and waives all procedures related to extradition if the person is arrested in another state while on bond; and (2) acknowledging that the person shall not be released prior to trial in any other state pending extradition to Kansas.
