Subject: House Bill 2602 – Bill Brief

House Bill 2602 would amend the Kansas virtual school act to require that a virtual school's graduation rate calculation shall only include those students who enrolled in the virtual school with sufficient credits to be expected to graduate in the same school year as such student's cohort group. HB 2602 would require that this graduation rate calculation be done only at the state level for accreditation purposes.
