We are writing to express that we are:

PROPONENTS of HB 2519 that represents the Bluestem Congress map.

OPPONENTS of HB 2520 that represents the Sunflower Map.

PROPONENTS of HB 2521 that represents the Buffalo 2 Map.

OPPONENTS of HB 2522 that represents the Ad Astra Map.

PROPONENTS: keeps the core communities of the greater Kansas City metropolitan area intact as much as possible. Keeps our shared community of interest together with its regional transportation, culture, and activity in the same district.

OPPONENT: breaks apart the core communities of the greater Kansas City metropolitan area. Splits Wyandotte County away from its shared cultural and regional ties with Johnson County. The Sunflower Map puts Wyandotte County in with the Big 1, stretching from the Missouri border all the way to the Colorado border. Wyandotte County has very little, if anything, in common with Western Kansas. The Ad Astra Map splits Wyandotte County in half, making it challenging to get elected officials' attention to address their community's shared interests.
