**MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2165

HB 2165 modifies the definition of “antique” for the purposes of antique vehicle registration.

Current law provides in K.S.A. 8-166 that antique means any vehicle more than 35 years old propelled by a motor using petroleum fuel, steam or electricity, or any combination thereof.

HB 2165 would modify that defined term, so that the definition of antique would apply to those vehicles more than 35 years old regardless of the age or type of components or equipment installed on the vehicle.

If enacted, the provisions of HB 2165 become effective July 1, 2021.
