Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2247

HB 2247 designates a portion of K-67 in Norton County as the COI Trenton J Brinkman memorial highway.

Section 1 provides that the COI Trenton J Brinkman memorial highway will begin on the portion of K-67 from the southern limits of the Norton correctional facility to the northern limits of the Norton correctional facility in Norton County. Highway signs designating the highway as the COI Trenton J Brinkman memorial highway will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the secretary of transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.
