Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2295

HB 2295 would exempt municipal motor grader vehicles from the Kansas Uniform Commercial Drivers' License Act requirements.

K.S.A. 8-2,125 through 8-1,142 contain the Kansas Uniform Commercial Drivers' License Act and the requirements for such act. This act follows the Federal Commercial Vehicle Safety Act of 1986 and the main purpose is to implement those federal laws.

K.S.A. 8-2,127 provides exemptions for certain vehicles from the uniform act. This bill creates a new exemption for motor grader vehicles operated by an employee of a municipality if such employee is operating the motor grader vehicle within the boundaries of such municipality.

If enacted, the provisions of HB 2295 become effective July 1, 2021.
