Subject: Bill Brief – SB 67

SB 67 amends the definitions of all-terrain vehicles and recreational off-highway vehicles.

"All-terrain vehicles" will now be defined as any motorized nonhighway vehicle up to 55 inches, increased from 50 inches under current law, and the new definition will have the width on the ATV measured from the "the outside of one tire rim to the outside of the other tire rim." Additionally, "Recreational off-highway vehicle" would be defined as any motor vehicle up to 75 inches, increased from 64 inches under current law, measured from the outside of one tire rim to the outside of the other tire rim, and the dry weight of ROVs will be increased from 2,000 to 3,500 pounds.
