House Bill 2085 would establish the student's right to know act. This act would require the Kansas State Department of Education to ensure that each student enrolled in grades 7 through 12 receives:

- The degree prospectus information published by the State Board of Regents pursuant to K.S.A. 74-32,303;
- the Kansas training information program report published pursuant to K.S.A. 74-32,418; and
- (3) any other information relevant to understanding potential earnings as determined by the department of labor and potential earnings published by each branch of the armed services.

HB 2085 would authorize KSDE to enter into any necessary agreements to implement this bill.

HB 2085 would take effect on January 1, 2022.
