Subject: SB 390 – Requiring election worker affidavits.

Senate Bill No. 390 (SB 390) would require each individual in a local election office that handles ballots to execute an affidavit that provides the number of blank, spoiled, and provisional ballots such individual handled, the name of the individual who delivered the ballots to the affiant, and where such ballots were received.

SB 390 would require the Secretary of State to develop a system for the creation and execution of these affidavits in consultation with local election officials.

If enacted, SB 390 would become effective on July 1, 2022.
