Subject: SB 445 – Prohibiting the use of any ballot drop boxes other than ones

located inside county election offices.

Senate Bill No. 445 (SB 445) would amend K.S.A. 25-1124, which governs the marking and return of advance voting ballots by voters. The bill would prohibit the use of any drop boxes for the deposit of advance voting ballots except those located in a county election office or satellite advance voting location. Those drop boxes that are permitted must be located inside the building of such locations and must be continuously observed by an employee during times when the box is accessible by the general public.

If enacted, SB 445 would become effective on July 1, 2022.
