SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2641 by Representative Howe, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2641 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2641 would prohibit the Board of Regents from fixing higher rates for tuition, fees and other charges for students who are not residents of this state than for students who are residents of this state.

The Kansas Board of Regents estimates the enactment of HB 2641 would decrease revenue to state universities from tuition and fees by approximately \$106.8 million. This estimate assumes no change in enrollment and is based on Academic Year 2021 tuition and fee revenue when approximately 34,250 nonresident students attended the state universities. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2641 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
