Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 8-160 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-160. As used in this act, the term "disabled veteran" means a person who has served in the armed forces of the United States and who is entitled to compensation for a service-connected *physical* disability *producing limited mobility* of at least 50% and the laws administered by the veterans administration or who is entitled to compensation for the loss, or permanent loss of use, of one or both feet or one or both hands, or for permanent visual impairment of both eyes to a prescribed degree.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 8-160 is hereby repealed.
- 17 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
