## $\overline{\text { AN ACT concerning crimes, punishment and criminal procedure; relating }}$ to crimes involving violations of personal rights; adding denial of civil rights based on a person's disability to the crime of denial of civil rights; amending K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 21-6102 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 21-6102 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-6102. (a) Denial of civil rights is intentionally denying to another person, on account of the race, color, ancestry, disability, national origin or religion of such other person the full and equal:
(1) Use and enjoyment of:
(A) The services, facilities, privileges and advantages of any institution, department or agency of the state of Kansas or any political subdivision or municipality thereof;
(2) use and enjoyment of
(B) the goods, services, facilities, privileges, advantages and accommodations of any establishment-which that provides lodging to transient guests for hire; -ff
(C) any establishment which that is engaged in selling food or beverage to the public for consumption upon the premises;-or of
(D) any place of recreation, amusement, exhibition or entertainment which that is open to members of the public;
(3) use and enjoyment of (E) the services, privileges and advantages of any facility for the public transportation of persons or goods;
(4) use and enjoyment of $(F)$ the services, facilities, privileges and advantages of any establishment whieh that offers personal or professional services to members of the public; or
(5)(2) exercise of the right to vote in any election held pursuant to the laws of Kansas.
(b) Denial of civil rights is a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 21-6102 is hereby repealed.
Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
