Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) Violence in the presence of a child is committing:
- (1) Assault, as defined in K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 21-5412, and amendments thereto, or battery, as defined in K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 21-5413, and amendments thereto, against a family or household member in the presence of a child; or
- (2) a felony violation of any crime described in article 54 or 55 of chapter 21 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, in the presence of a child.
- (b) (1) Violence in the presence of a child as defined in subsection (a) (1) is a:
- (A) Class A person misdemeanor except as provided in subsection (b) (1)(B); and
- (B) severity level 7, person felony on a second or subsequent conviction.
- (2) Violence in the presence of a child as defined in subsection (a)(2) is a severity level 5, person felony.
- (c) If multiple children are present during a violation of this section, the presence of each child shall be considered a separate violation of this section.
 - (d) As used in this section:
- (1) "In the presence of a child" means in the physical presence of a child or with knowledge that a child may see or hear such crime being committed; and
 - (2) "child" means a person under 18 years of age.
- 30 (e) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas criminal code.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
