AN ACT concerning real property; enacting the Kansas vacant property 1 2 act; prohibiting municipalities from imposing certain fees and other 3 requirements on vacant property. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 6 Section 1. (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the 7 Kansas vacant property act. 8 (b) As used in this section: 9 (1)"Municipality" means any city, county, township or other political 10 or taxing subdivision; (2) "vacant property" means any parcel of residential or commercial 11 12 real estate that: 13 (A) For property consisting of a single unit, is not occupied; or (B) for property consisting of multiple units, has one or more units 14 that are not occupied. 15 (c) No municipality shall adopt or enforce any ordinance, resolution 16 or regulation and no agent of any municipality shall take any 17 18 administrative action that requires any owner, operator or manager of any 19 vacant property to: 20 (1) Register or otherwise submit such property to such municipality 21 for inclusion in a record of vacant properties maintained by such 22 municipality or any agent thereof; or 23 (2) pay any tax, fee or other charge for such property if such tax, fee 24 or other charge is levied, assessed or otherwise imposed on the basis that 25 such property is vacant property. 26 (d) Any ordinance, resolution or regulation prohibited by subsection 27 (c) that was adopted prior to July 1, 2022, shall be null and void. 28 (e) For purposes of this section, property shall be considered vacant 29 regardless of the cause of such vacancy, including, but not limited to, 30 default, foreclosure, probate or bankruptcy. 31 (f) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or otherwise 32 limit a municipality from adopting or enforcing any ordinances, 33 resolutions or regulations concerning vacant property that are applicable to 34 other real property located in such municipality. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 35 Sec 2 36 publication in the statute book.
