AN ACT concerning the legislature; relating to bills; requiring legislators 1 2 who request certain curriculum or school finance bills to volunteer at a 3 public school or consult with a team of teaching professionals; 4 prohibiting certain legislators from requesting bills that divert state 5 moneys from public schools to private schools. 6 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 8 Section 1. (a) This act shall be known and may be cited as the 9 legislator empowerment and protection program. 10 (b) (1) Prior to requesting a bill for introduction that would impact 11 public school curriculum or the provision of finance for public schools, a 12 legislator desiring to make such request shall either: 13 Volunteer for a week in a public school in this state; or (A) consult with a team of at least six teaching professionals 14 (B) 15 designated by the state board of education. (2) Upon completion of the requirement of paragraph (1), a legislator 16 may request the introduction of a bill that would impact public school 17 18 curriculum or the provision of finance for public schools. 19 (c) To protect legislators from a conflict of interest, a legislator who 20 is the parent of a minor child enrolled in a nonpublic school, including a 21 home school, shall not request for introduction any bill that would divert 22 state moneys from public schools to nonpublic schools. 23 (d) This section does not apply to bills requested for introduction by a 24 state agency and approved for introduction by a legislative committee or 25 committee members. 26 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 27 publication in the statute book.
