The **agency** requests a revised estimate of \$613,633, all from special revenue funds, in FY 2021. This is a decrease of \$16,746, or 2.7 percent, below the amount approved by the 2020 Legislature. The decrease is primarily due to fewer travel reimbursements paid out to advisory committee members traveling to physical meeting locations (\$10,286); lower expenditures for unclassified temporary pay (\$8,000); and adjustments for employer contributions to the public employees retirement system (\$3,200).
