Agency Request

The **agency** requests expenditures of \$2.0 million, including \$852,901 SGF, for FY 2023. This is an all funds increase of \$36,006, or 1.8 percent, and an SGF increase of \$141,312, or 19.9 percent, above the agency's FY 2022 revised estimate. This increase is to fund a full year's salary and benefits for the additional FTE position requested in the FY 2022 revised estimate. The IT employee would continue to develop remote hearing capabilities to allow the Board to conduct hearings remotely. This FTE position is fully funded by SGF moneys.

In addition to funding the additional FTE position, the agency requests a decrease of \$103,306 from the COTA Filing Fee Fund, and an increase of \$100,000 SGF. This reverses a FY 2022 change recommended by the Governor, and approved by the Legislature as part of the agency's reduced resources package.

Governor's Recommendation

The **Governor** recommends expenditures of \$2.0 million, including \$873,554 SGF, for FY 2023. This is an all funds increase of \$20,653, or 1.0 percent, including an SGF increase of \$20,653, or 2.4 percent, above the agency's FY 2023 request.
