

MINUTES OF THE SENATE ASSESSMENT AND TAXATION COMMITTEE.

Senator Corbin called the Committee's attention to **HB 3032**, which was heard and discussed by the Committee on May 2, 2002. He reminded the Committee that Senator Clark moved to recommend **HB 3032** favorably for passage, and Senator Donovan seconded the motion; however, the meeting was adjourned without a vote on the motion.

On a call for a vote on Senator Clark's motion, the Chairman was in doubt of the voice vote. On a show of hands, the motion carried.

HB 3023—Property taxation; determination of fair market value

Senator Corbin reminded the Committee that the provisions of **HB 3023** passed the Senate twice—in **SB 92** during the 2001 Session and in **HB 2795** during the 2002 Session. He noted that the bill deals with property tax from appraisers and that it passed the House.

Senator Jenkins moved to recommend **HB 3023** favorably for passage, seconded by Senator Lee. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.
