

2021 Kansas Statutes

84-9-603. Agreement on standards concerning rights and duties. (a) Agreed standards. The parties may determine by agreement the standards measuring the fulfillment of the rights of a debtor or obligor and the duties of a secured party under a rule stated in K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 84-9-602, and amendments thereto, if the standards are not manifestly unreasonable.

(b) Agreed standards inapplicable to breach of peace. Subsection (a) does not apply to the duty under K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 84-9-609, and amendments thereto, to refrain from breaching the peace.
