AN ACT concerning crimes and punishment; relating to unlawful use or possession of a sale receipt or universal product code label.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Unlawful use of a sales receipt or universal product code label is possessing, using, uttering, transferring, making, altering, counterfeiting or reproducing a retail sales receipt or a universal product code label with the intent to cheat or defraud a retailer.

- (b) Unlawful possession of a sales receipt or universal product code label is possessing 15 of more fraudulent retail sales receipts or universal product code labels, or any combination thereof, or possessing the device which manufactures fraudulent retail sales receipts or universal product code labels with the intent to cheat or defraud a retailer.
  - (c) Violation of subsection (a) is a severity level 9, nonperson felony.
  - (d) Violation of subsection (b) is a severity level 8, nonperson felony.
- (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas criminal code.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
