AN ACT concerning mausoleums or burial vaults or structures; amending K.S.A. 17-1324 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 17-1324 is hereby amended to read as follows: 17-1324. When Before any person, firm, or corporation, shall desire to build, construct, or creet or other entity constructs or erects any mausoleum, vault; or burial structure, the same to be built or constructed or erected entirely above the ground, or partly by excavation, and to be built, constructed and erected so that the same it may contain one or more deceased human bodies for permanent interment, before proceeding to build, construct, or creet such mausoleum, vault or other structure, shall present and such person or entity shall file a copy of all the plans and specifications for such the construction and erection with the secretary of health and environment of the state of Kansas, and the board of mortuary arts. Before approving such plans and specifications said the secretary shall be satisfied beyond any doubt that the said mausoleum, vault, or other structure would be absolutely permanent and sanitary, and. If the plans and specifications are approved, said the approval shall be evidenced by a written certificate in writing signed by the secretary, may proceed with. Upon such approval, the construction and erection of such mausoleum, vault or other structure may proceed.

- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
