AN ACT abolishing the tax upon gross earnings derived from money, notes and other evidence of debt; amending K.S.A. 12-140 and repealing the existing section; also repealing K.S.A. 12-1,101 through 12-1,108 and 12-1,110 and K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 12-1,109.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. For all taxable years commencing after December 31, 2000, the imposition of a tax upon the gross earnings derived from money, notes and other evidence of debt by a city, county or township is hereby prohibited. Any resolution or ordinance imposing such tax for any such year is hereby declared null and void.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 12-140 is hereby amended to read as follows: 12-140. Except as otherwise specifically authorized by K.S.A. 12-1,101 to 12-1,109, no No city shall have power to levy and collect taxes on incomes from whatever source derived.
- Sec. 3. K.S.A. 12-140, 12-1,101 through 12-1,108 and 12-1,110 and K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 12-1,109 are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
