9 AN ACT concerning the sale of cereal malt beverages; amending K.S.A. 10 41-2704 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 41-2704 is hereby amended to read as follows: 41-14 2704. (a) In addition to and consistent with the requirements of this act, 15the board of county commissioners of any county or the governing body 16 of any city may prescribe hours of closing, standards of conduct and rules 17and regulations concerning the moral, sanitary and health conditions of 18places licensed pursuant to this act and may establish zones within which 19 no such place may be located. 20(b) Except as provided by subsection (g), no cereal malt beverages 21may be sold: 22 (1) Between the hours of 12 midnight and 6 a.m.; or - (2) on Sunday, except in a place of business which is licensed to sell 2324cereal malt beverage for consumption on the premises, which derives not 25less than 30% of its gross receipts from the sale of food for consumption 26 on the licensed premises and which is located in a county where such sales on Sunday have been authorized by resolution of the board of county 2728commissioners of the county or in a city where such sales on Sunday have 29 been authorized by ordinance of the governing body of the city. 30 (b) Except as provided by subsection (g), cereal malt beverages shall 31 not be sold between the hours of 12 midnight or 6 a.m. 32 No private rooms or closed booths shall be operated in a place of (c) 33 business, but this provision shall not apply if the licensed premises are 34 also currently also are licensed as a club pursuant to the club and drinking 35 establishment act. 36 Each place of business shall be open to the public and to law (d) 37 enforcement officers at all times during business hours, except that a. 38 Premises licensed as a club pursuant to the club and drinking establish-39 ment act shall be open to law enforcement officers and during nonbusi-40*ness hours but* not to the public.

(e) No licensee shall permit a person under the legal age for consumption of cereal malt beverage to consume or purchase any cereal malt
beverage in or about a place of business<del>, and</del>. No licensee shall permit a

person under the legal age for consumption of cereal malt beverage to
 possess cereal malt beverage in or about a place of business, except that.
 A licensee's employee who is not less than 18 years of age may dispense
 or sell cereal malt beverage, if:

5 (1) The licensee's place of business is licensed only to sell cereal malt 6 beverage at retail in original and unopened containers and not for con-7 sumption on the premises; or

8 (2) the licensee's place of business is a licensed food service estab-9 lishment, as defined by K.S.A. 36-501, and amendments thereto, and not 10 less than 50% of the gross receipts from the licensee's place of business 11 is derived from the sale of food for consumption on the premises of the 12 licensed place of business.

(f) No person shall have any alcoholic liquor in such person's possession while in a place of business, unless the premises are currently licensed as a club or drinking establishment pursuant to the club and drinking establishment act.

(g) Cereal malt beverages may be sold on premises which are licensed
pursuant to both the acts contained in article 27 of chapter 41 of the
Kansas Statutes Annotated and the club and drinking establishment act
at any time when alcoholic liquor is allowed by law to be served on the
premises.

22 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 41-2704 is hereby repealed.
