9 AN ACT concerning economic development; creating the airport serv-10 ices improvement fund; providing for financial incentives for development and improvement of airline service from existing airports; pre-11 scribing certain powers, duties and functions for the secretary of 13 commerce and housing; amending K.S.A. 79-4801 and repealing the 14 existing section. 15

16 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

17 New Section 1. (a) The secretary of commerce and housing shall establish and implement a financial incentive program which shall be 18 known as the airport services improvement program. The airport services 19 20 improvement program shall provide grants and other financial incentive 21 for development and improvement of airline services from existing airports to reduce the costs of commercial air carriers in providing air trans-22 23 portation services to individuals, businesses and public agencies so that 24 the costs of such services to individuals, businesses and public agencies 25 are stabilized and reduced. The secretary of commerce and housing shall 26 make grants and provide other financial incentives in accordance with the 27 airport services improvement program.

28 (b) There is hereby created in the state treasury the airport services 29 improvement fund which shall be administered by the secretary of com-30 merce and housing. All expenditures from the airport services improve-31 ment fund shall be to provide financial incentives for development and 32 improvement of airline service from existing airports under the airport services improvement program in accordance with this section. All ex-33 penditures from the airport services improvement fund shall be made on 34 35 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary of commerce and housing or the secretary's 36 37 designee.

(c) On July 1 of each year and after the transfer of moneys pursuant 38 39 to K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 79-4806 and amendments thereto, or as soon there-40 after as sufficient moneys are available, \$5,000,000 credited to the state gaming revenues fund shall be transferred and credited to the airport 41 42 services improvement fund.

43 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 79-4801 is hereby amended to read as follows: 79-

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4801. There is hereby created the state gaming revenues fund in the state treasury. All moneys credited to such fund shall be expended or trans-ferred only for the purposes and in the manner provided by this act and all expenditures from the state gaming revenues fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts. All moneys credited to such fund shall be allocated and credited monthly to the funds and in the amounts spec-ified by this act except that the total of the amounts credited to such funds in any one fiscal year pursuant to this act shall not exceed \$50,000,000 \$55,000,000. All amounts credited to such fund in any one fiscal year which are in excess of \$50,000,000 \$55,000,000 shall be trans-ferred and credited to the state general fund on July 15, 1996, and June 25, 1997, and each year thereafter on June 25 of each year.

13 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 79-4801 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the statute book.
