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AN ACT relating to accident and health insurance; providing coverage
for autism; amending K.S.A. 40-2,103 and 40-19c09 and repealing the
existing sections.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14 New Section 1. (a) Any individual or group health insurance policy, 15 medical service plan, contract, hospital service corporation contract, hospital and medical service corporation contract, fraternal benefit society 16 17 or health maintenance organization which provides coverage for accident and health services which is delivered, issued for delivery, amended or 18 renewed on or after July 1, 2001, shall provide coverage for autism. Such 19 20 coverage for autism shall include speech therapy by a speech language 21 pathologist licensed pursuant to K.S.A. 65-6501 et seq., and amendments 22 thereto.

(b) The benefits provided in this act shall be subject to the same
annual deductible or co-insurance established for all other covered benefits within a given policy.

10	cludes, limits or otherwise restricts coverage because medicaid benefits
11	as permitted by title XIX of the social security act of 1965 are or may be
12	available for the same accident or illness.
13	(c) Violation of subsection (b) shall be subject to the penalties pre-
14	scribed by K.S.A. 40-2407 and 40-2411, and amendments thereto.
15	New Sec. 4. The provisions of K.S.A. 40-2249a, and amendments
16	thereto, shall not apply to the provisions of this act.
17	Sec. 5. K.S.A. 40-2,103 and 40-19c09 are hereby repealed.
18	Sec. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
19	publication in the statute book.
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
