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12	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
13	Section 1. (a) There is hereby created the central payment center
14	advisory commission.
15	(b) Commission members shall include:
16	(1) A district court judge whose jurisdiction includes domestic
17	relations;
18	(2) a county or district attorney or court trustee who works in child
19	support enforcement;
20	(3) a district court clerk;
21	(4) a child support worker;
22	(5) a member of the legislature;
23	(6) an employer, with more than 75 employees, who provides income
24	withholding;
25	(7) an employer, with less than 25 employees, who provides income
26	withholding;
27	(8) a custodial parent who has a court order to receive child support;

(f) The staff of the legislative research department, the office of the
revisor of statutes and the division of legislative administrative services
shall provide such assistance as may be requested by the commission and
to the extent authorized by the legislative coordinating council.

(g) Members of the commission attending meetings of the committee, or attending a subcommittee meeting thereof authorized by the legislative coordinating council, shall be paid compensation, travel expenses
and subsistence expenses or allowances as provided in K.S.A. 75-3212
and amendments thereto.

(h) The central payment center advisory commission shall:

(1) Recommend to the department of social and rehabilitation services, if appropriate, ways to improve or enhance the effectiveness of the
central unit for the collection and disbursement of support payments;

20 (2) recommend performance indicators for the central unit;

(3) recommend legislation which would clarify and improve state law
 regarding support for children as it relates to the central unit; and

(4) present an annual report of its activities and recommendations tothe legislative coordinating council by February 1.

25 (i) The provisions of this section shall expire on July 1, 2005.

26 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 27 publication in the statute book.

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
