AN ACT concerning hospital districts; relating to the detachment of ter-ritory therefrom.

## 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14Section 1. (a) Any territory which is a part of a hospital district 15formed or governed by K.S.A. 80-2501 et seq., and amendments thereto, 16 may be detached from such hospital district in the manner provided in 17this section. Upon the presentation to the board of county commissioners, 18 of the county in which the hospital is located, of a petition setting forth 19 the boundaries of the territory to be detached from the taxing district of 20 the hospital, stating that a person who has signed the petition may with-21draw such person's name from the petition by giving written notice 22 thereof at any time within three days following the date of signing the 23 petition, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, to the county 24election officer of the county in which the hospital is located and signed 25by not less than 51% of the qualified electors of the territory to be de-26 tached, to be determined by enumeration taken and verified for this pur-27 pose by the county election officer of the county in which the hospital is 28located, it shall be the duty of the board of county commissioners, at its 29 next regular meeting, to examine the petition. If the board of county 30 commissioners finds that the petition is sufficient, regular and in due form 31 as provided in this section, the board shall enter an order in its proceed-32 ings detaching the territory described in the petition from the taxing dis-33 trict of the hospital. The petition shall be accompanied by a copy of a 34 resolution adopted by the board, which resolution shall state that the 35 board desires such territory to be detached from the taxing district of the 36 hospital.

(b) For tax purposes, detachment of territory pursuant to this section
shall be effective as provided in K.S.A. 79-1807, and amendments thereto.
Such territory so detached shall not be liable for payment of outstanding
bonded indebtedness of the taxing district of the hospital, except for payment of bonds issued during the period such territory was attached to

42 the district. If any such taxing district has authorized the issuance of bonds

43 at a special election, the election shall not be affected by the passage of

- this act, and the bonds authorized at the election may be legally issued
  notwithstanding the detachment of any portion of the taxing district which
  was included at the date of the bond election.
- 4 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 5 publication in the statute book.
