9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas dental board; membership thereof;
10 amending K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-1404 and repealing the existing
11 section.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-1404 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 74-1404. (a) In order to accomplish the purpose and to provide 16 for the enforcement of this act, there is hereby created the Kansas dental 17board. The board shall be vested with authority to carry out the purposes 18and enforce the provisions of this act. The board shall consist of the 19 following: (1) Six licensed and qualified resident dentists; (2) two licensed 20 and qualified resident dental hygienists; and (3) one representative of the 21general public. On May 1, 2001, and prior to May 1, 2002, the board 22 shall consist of the following: (1) Five licensed and qualified resident den-23tists; (2) three licensed and qualified resident dental hygienists; and (3) 24three representatives of the general public. On and after May 1, 2002, the 25board shall consist of the following: (1) Four licensed and qualified resi-26 dent dentists; (2) four licensed and qualified resident dental hygienists; 27 and (3) three representatives of the general public. At least 30 days before 28the expiration of any term, other than that of the member appointed from 29 the general public or a member who is a dental hygienist the term of a 30 dentist member of the board, the Kansas dental association or its successor 31 shall submit to the governor a list of three names of persons of recognized 32 ability who have the qualifications prescribed for the dentist board mem-33 bers. At least 30 days before the expiration of the term of the a dental 34 hygienist member of the board, the Kansas dental hygiene association 35 shall submit to the governor a list of three names of persons of recognized 36 ability who have the qualifications prescribed for the dental hygienist 37 member members. For the four new members dental hygienist member 38 to be appointed under this act subsequent to April 30, 2001, such names 39 name shall be submitted within 10 days after the effective date of this 40act. The governor shall consider such list of persons in making the ap-41pointment to the board.

42 (b) The members shall be appointed by the governor in the manner 43 hereinafter prescribed for terms of four years and until their successors are appointed and qualified. Of the six licensed dentists on the board,
 one shall be appointed from each congressional district and two prior to
 May 1, 2002, one shall be appointed from the state at large. On and after
 the effective date of this act, On and after May 1, 2002, of the four licensed
 dentists on the board, one shall be appointed from each congressional
 district.

7 No person shall be appointed for more than two consecutive four-(c)year terms. No person in any way connected with a dental supply or dental 8 9 laboratory business shall be eligible for appointment to the board. No 10 person shall be eligible for appointment to the board who has been con-11 victed of a violation of any of the provisions of this or any other prior dental practice act or who has been convicted of a felony. A dentist who 12is an officer of the Kansas dental association shall not be eligible for 13 14 appointment to the Kansas dental board. A dental hygienist who is an 15officer of the Kansas dental hygienists association shall not be eligible for 16 appointment to the Kansas dental board. No dentist or dental hygienist 17shall be appointed to the board who has not been engaged in the active 18practice of dentistry or dental hygiene in the state of Kansas for at least 19 five years next preceding appointment.

(d) Whenever a vacancy occurs it shall be filled by appointment for
the remainder of the unexpired term in the same manner as an original
appointment is made.

(e) Upon the effective date of this act, in order to expand the mem-2324bership to the preseribed six dentists and two dental hygienists, the gov-25ernor shall appoint three additional dentists and one additional hygienist to the board in the manner described in this section. Of the three new 26 dental members, one shall serve until April 30, 2000, one shall serve until 27April 30, 2001 and one shall serve until April 30, 2002, as designated by 2829 the governor. Thereafter, all terms shall be four-year terms beginning 30 May 1 of the appointment year and expiring April 30 four years later. 31 When the terms of the existing dentist members which expire May 1, 32 2000, and May 1, 2001 conclude, then successors shall be appointed for 33 four year terms beginning May 1 and expiring April 30 four years later. 34 The additional dental hygienist appointed upon the effective date of this 35 act shall serve until April 30, 2002, and thereafter the successor shall serve 36 a four-year term beginning May 1 and expiring April 30 four years later. 37 Upon the expiration of terms of office of members, successors shall be appointed in the same manner as original appointments provided for ap-38 39 pointments under this section for terms of four years. 40 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-1404 is hereby repealed.
