AN ACT concerning <del>public</del> schools; relating to programs of patriotic ex ercises; amending K.S.A. 72-5308 and repealing the existing section.

17 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 72-5308 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-18 5308. It shall be the duty of The state board of education to shall prepare 19 20 for the use of the public schools and accredited nonpublic schools a 21 program providing for patriotic exercises as may be deemed by it the state board to be expedient appropriate, under such instructions as may best 22 23 meet the varied requirements of the different grades in such schools. The program of patriotic observation of every school district shall include a 24 25 daily recitation of the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States 26 of America and a daily recitation of the following excerpt from the Declaration of Independence: 27

28 "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, 29 that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, 30 that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That to 31 secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their 32 just powers from the consent of the governed...".

33 It The state board of education also shall also make provision for the
34 observance in public schools of Lincoln's birthday, Washington's birthday,
35 Memorial day, and Flag day, and such other legal holidays of like char36 acter as may be designated by law.

37 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-5308 is hereby repealed.

38 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its39 publication in the statute book.
