8 AN ACT concerning legal publications; amending K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 64-9 10 101 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 64-101 is hereby amended to read as follows: 64-101. (a) The governing body of each city of the first class shall 14 15 designate by resolution a newspaper to be the official city newspaper. Once designated, the newspaper shall be the official city newspaper until 16 17 such time as the governing body designates a different newspaper. No legal notice, advertisement or publication of any kind required or 18 provided by any of the laws of the state of Kansas, to be published in a 19 20 newspaper shall have any force or effect unless the same is published in 21 a newspaper which: (1) Is published at least weekly 50 times a year and has been so pub-22 23 lished for at least one year five years prior to the publication of any official 24 city publication: 25 (2)is entered at the post office as periodical class mail matter; 26 (3) has general paid circulation on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly 27 basis in the county in which the city is located and is not a trade, religious 28 or fraternal publication; and 29 (4) is published in the county in which the city publishing the official 30 publication is located. If there is no newspaper published in the county, the newspaper shall be published in Kansas and shall have general paid 31 32 circulation in the county. The board of county commissioners of each county shall designate 33 (b) 34 by resolution a newspaper to be the official county newspaper. Once 35 designated the newspaper shall be the official county newspaper until 36 such time as the board designates a different newspaper. The newspaper 37 selected for the official publications of a county shall be a newspaper which: 38 39 Is published at least weekly 50 times each year and has been so (1) 40 published for at least one year five years prior to the publication of any 41 official county publication; 42 (2) is entered at the post office in the county of publication as peri-43 odical class mail matter, which county shall be located in Kansas;

(3) has general paid circulation on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly basis in the county and is not a trade, religious or fraternal publication; and

4 (4) is published in the county publishing the official publication. If 5 there is no newspaper published in the county, the newspaper shall be 6 printed published in Kansas and have general paid circulation in the 7 county.

8 (c) Whenever the board of education of a school district is required
9 to publish a legal notice, advertisement or other publication in a news10 paper having general circulation in the school district, such newspaper
11 shall be one which:

12 (1) Is published at least weekly 50 times each year and has been so
13 published for at least one year five years prior to the publication of any
14 school district publication;

(2) is entered at the post office in the school district of publication
as periodical class mail matter;

17 (3) has general paid circulation on a daily, weekly, monthly or yearly
18 basis in the school district and is not a trade, religious or fraternal pub19 lication; and

(4) is published in the school district publishing the official publication. If there is no newspaper published in the school district, the newspaper shall be published in Kansas and shall have general paid circulation
in the school district.

24 (d) Nothing contained in this section shall invalidate the publication 25 in a newspaper which has resumed publication after having suspended 26 publication all or part of the time that the United States has been engaged 27 in war with any foreign nation and six months next following the cessation of hostilities if such newspaper resumes publication in good faith under 28 the same ownership as it had when it suspended publication. Nothing in 29 30 this section shall invalidate the publication in a newspaper which has 31 simply changed its name or moved its place of publication from one part 32 of the county to another part, or suspended publication on account of fire, flood, strikes, shortages of materials or other unavoidable accidents 33 for not to exceed 10 weeks within the year last preceding the first pub-34 35 lication of the legal notice, advertisement or publication. All legal publications heretofore made which otherwise would be valid, that have 36 37 been made in a newspaper which, on account of flood, fire, strikes, shortages of materials or other unavoidable accident, has suspended publica-38 tion for a period of not exceeding 10 weeks, are hereby legalized. 39

40 (e) In addition to the requirements established in subsection (b), in

41 any county having a population of 100,000 or over, no legal notice, ad-

42 vertisement or publication of any kind required or provided by any of the

43 laws of the state of Kansas shall have any force or effect unless the same
