8 9 AN ACT concerning compensation and allowances for members of the legislature; amending K.S.A. 46-137a and repealing the existing 10 11 section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 46-137a is hereby amended to read as follows: 46-14 15 137a. In addition to the compensation provided for by K.S.A. 46-137b, 46-137e and 75-3212 and amendments thereto, each member of the leg-16 islature shall receive the following amounts: 17 The sum of \$72.06 *\$100* per calendar day for service at any regular 18 (a) or special session, except as otherwise provided in subsection (e); 19 20 (b) the sum of \$80 *\$100* per calendar day for subsistence allowance 21 for any regular or special session of the legislature, except that if the amounts allowable for the capital city of Kansas under applicable federal 22 23 law and regulations to employees of the executive branch of the federal 24 government for per diem expenses, while away from home but serving in 25 the United States, are amounts which total greater than \$80 \$100, then 26 each member of the legislature shall receive such greater total amount 27 per calendar day for subsistence allowance for any regular or special ses-28 sion of the legislature; (c) an allowance of \$270 \$478.85 for the two-week period which co-29 incides with the first biweekly payroll period commencing in April and 30 31 for each of the 19 ensuing two-week periods thereafter, to defray expenses incurred between sessions of the legislature for postage, tele-32 phone, office and other incidental expenses; 33 34 (d) an allowance for mileage in an amount equal to the rate per mile 35 prescribed under the provisions of K.S.A. 75-3203a and amendments thereto multiplied by the number of miles traveled by the usual route in 36 37 going to and returning from the member's place of residence for any regular or special session of the legislature. Such mileage allowances shall 38 be paid for not to exceed the equivalent of one trip for each full week 39 40 occurring between convening and adjournment sine die in any regular or special session. The mileage allowance provided under the provisions of 41 42 this subsection shall not be subject to the restrictions relating to the use 43 of vehicles prescribed by K.S.A. 75-3203 and 75-3203a and amendments

thereto but shall only be allowed for trips actually made. Compensation
and subsistence allowance shall not be allowed under the provisions of
subsections (a) and (b) of this section during any period in which the
legislature is adjourned for more than two days, Sundays excepted; and

(e) (1) whenever the rates of compensation of the pay plan for persons 5 in the classified service under the Kansas civil service act are increased 6 7 for payroll periods chargeable to fiscal years commencing after June 30, 8 1999 2002, the rate of compensation per calendar day for members of 9 the legislature for service at any regular or special session of the legislature 10 under subsection (a), the rate of subsistence allowance per calendar day under subsection (b) and the rate of allowance per two-week period under 11 subsection (c) shall be increased on the effective date of any such pay 12 13 plan increase by an amount computed by multiplying the average of the percentage increases in all steps of such pay plan by the each such rate 14 15 of compensation per calendar day which is authorized by this section for service at any regular or special session of the legislature for the day upon 16 which such increase is computed and which is in effect prior to the effec-17 18 tive date of such pay plan increase.

(2) If increases in the biweekly rates of compensation from step move-19 20 ments of the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the Kansas 21 civil service act are authorized for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, 22 or any fiscal year thereafter, the rate of compensation per calendar day 23 under subsection (a), the rate of subsistence allowance under subsection 24 (b) and the rate of allowance per two-week period under subsection (c) 25 shall be increased by an amount computed by multiplying the average 26 percentage increase in the biweekly rate of compensation from step move-27 ments on the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the Kansas civil service act determined under paragraph (3) of this subsection 28 (e) by each such rate which is authorized by this section and which is in 29 30 effect prior to the effective date of such increase. The increase in the rate of compensation per calendar day under subsection (a), the rate of sub-31 32 sistence allowance under subsection (b) and the rate of allowance per twoweek period under subsection (c) shall take effect on the first day of the 33 first payroll period which is chargeable to the fiscal year in which such 34 35 step movements on the pay plan are authorized to take effect.

36 (3) For purposes of paragraph (2) of this subsection (e), the average 37 percentage increase in the biweekly rate of compensation from step move-38 ments on the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the 39 Kansas civil service act shall be equal to the percentage certified by the 40 secretary of administration which equals the estimated average of the 41 percentage increases in all biweekly rates of compensation from step 42 movements on the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the 43 Kansas of the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the 44 Kansas of the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the 45 Kansas of the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the 46 Kansas of the pay plan for persons in the classified service under the

7	centage increase shall be used to increase the rate of compensation per
8	calendar day under subsection (a), the rate of subsistence allowance under
9	subsection (b) and the rate of allowance per two-week period under sub-
10	section (c) instead of applying the increases under subsections (1) and (2)
11	of this subsection (e) separately.
12	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 46-137a is hereby repealed.
13	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after June
14	10, 2001, and its publication in the Kansas register.
