AN ACT concerning retirement; relating to the Kansas police and firemen's retirement system; purchase of service credit; amending K.S.A.
2000 Supp. 74-4963 and 74-4963a and repealing the existing sections.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-4963 is hereby amended to read as 14 15 follows: 74-4963. (1) Upon termination of employment prior to the com-16 pletion of 20 years of credited service, after 30 days after such termination 17 a member may withdraw such member's accumulated contributions or elect to leave such accumulated contributions on deposit with the system. 18 If the member elects to leave the accumulated contributions on deposit 19 20 with the system and if the member returns to employment with the same 21 or another participating employer within five years, such member shall receive credit for such member's service prior to such termination. If the 22 23 member does not elect to leave the accumulated contributions on deposit 24 or if the member does not return to covered employment within five 25 years, such member shall no longer be a member of the system and the 26 sum of such member's accumulated contributions then on deposit with this system shall be paid to such member after making application in a 27 28 form prescribed by the board and after the system has a reasonable time to process the application for withdrawal. Upon proper notification by 29 30 the system, member contributions not on deposit with the system shall be paid to the member by the participating employer. 31

(2) If, after termination and withdrawal of accumulated contribu-32 tions, a former member returns to covered employment, except as oth-33 34 erwise provided in subsection (1), the former member shall become a 35 member of the system as provided in subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4955 and amendments thereto. Any former member returning to covered em-36 37 ployment may, at the former member's option, pay to the system within 38 31 days of the former member's return to covered employment, the total 39 of the former member's withdrawn accumulated contributions plus in-40 terest at a rate specified by the board, in which case the member shall receive full credit for the member's service prior to the member's ter-41 mination. Subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74 49,123 and 42 43 amendments thereto, members who do not elect to repay within 31 days

of return to covered employment may elect to purchase previously for-1 2 feited service any time prior to retirement. Such purchase shall be made 3 by a lump sum payment equal to 1.75% of the member's current annual salary for each quarter of previously forfeited participating service which 4 the member elects to repurchase. purchase service credit for such pre-5 viously forfeited service credit, subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 6 Supp. 74-49,123, and amendments thereto, at an additional rate of con-7 tribution, in addition to the employee's rate of contribution as provided 8 9 in K.S.A. 74-4919, and amendments thereto, based upon the member's 10 attained age at the time of purchase and using actuarial assumptions and tables in use by the retirement system at such time of purchase for such 11 periods of service. Such additional rate of contribution shall commence 12 at the beginning of the quarter following such election and shall remain 13 in effect until all quarters of such service have been purchased. Subject 14 15 to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-49,123, and amendments thereto, such member may elect to effect such purchase by means of a 16 17 single lump-sum payment in lieu of the increased amount of the employee's contribution rate otherwise provided for in this act in an amount 18 equal to the then present value of the benefits being purchased determined 19 20 by the actuary using the member's attained age, annual compensation at 21 the time of purchase and the actuarial assumptions and tables then in use by the retirement system. The lump-sum payment shall be made imme-22 23 diately upon being notified of the amount due. Upon receipt of such payment by the system the member shall receive full credit for the number 24 25 of previously forfeited quarters of participating service which the member 26 has elected to repurchase. Any member who repurchases all of the mem-27 ber's previously forfeited participating service credit shall also receive all 28 of the member's previously forfeited prior service credit.

(3) Upon termination and withdrawal of accumulated contributions,
any member whose employment was, up to the member's employer's
entry date, covered by a pension system established under the provisions
of K.S.A. 13-14a01 through 13-14a14, and amendments thereto, or K.S.A.
14-10a01 through 14-10a15, and amendments thereto, shall be entitled
to receive from the member's employer the sum of the member's accumulated contributions to the previous pension system.

(4) If a member has completed 20 years of credited service at date 36 37 of termination, the member shall be granted automatically a vested retirement benefit in the system, but any time prior to the commencement 38 39 of retirement benefit payments and before attaining age 55 the member 40 may withdraw the member's accumulated contributions, whereupon the member's membership in this system ceases and no other amounts shall 41 be payable for the member's prior and participating service credit. Eli-42 43 gibility of such member, who has not withdrawn the member's accumu-

lated contributions, for retirement benefits and procedures for making 1 2 application for retirement benefits shall be in accordance with K.S.A. 74-4957 and amendments thereto, except that in lieu of the three-month 3 notice of intention to retire being made to the employer, such member 4 shall make application for retirement in a form prescribed by the board 5 and retirement benefits shall accrue from the first day of the month fol-6 lowing receipt of such application. The amount of the retirement benefit 7 shall be determined as provided in K.S.A. 74-4958 and amendments 8 thereto. 9

10 (5) If a member, who has a vested retirement benefit, again becomes an employee of a participating employer, the amount of the member's 11 vested retirement benefit shall remain in effect, and any retirement ben-12 efit such member subsequently accrues shall be calculated separately 13 based on credited service after again becoming an employee and shall be 14 15 added to that which had been vested by virtue of previous service. Eligibility of such member for retirement benefits and procedures for mak-16 ing application for retirement benefits shall be in accordance with K.S.A. 17 74-4957 and amendments thereto. 18

(6) Any member of this system who was previously a member of the 19 20 Kansas public employees retirement system or the retirement system for 21 judges and who forfeited service credit under either of those systems by reason of termination of employment and withdrawal of their contribu-22 23 tions to that system, may elect, subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 24 Supp. 74-49,123 and amendments thereto, to purchase service credit for 25 the previously forfeited service credit by means of a single lump-sum 26 payment and such service shall be recredited to that system. The amount of the lump-sum payment shall be determined by the actuary using the 27 member's then current annual rate of compensation and the actuarial 28 assumptions and tables then currently in use by that retirement system. 29

(7) The provisions of this section shall apply only to members who
were appointed or employed prior to July 1, 1989, and who did not make
an election pursuant to K.S.A. 74-4955a and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-4963a is hereby amended to read as 33 follows: 74-4963a. (1) Upon termination of employment prior to the com-34 35 pletion of 15 years of credited service, after 30 days after such termination a member may withdraw such member's accumulated contributions or 36 37 elect to leave such accumulated contributions on deposit with the system. If the member elects to leave the accumulated contributions on deposit 38 39 with the system and if the member returns to employment with the same 40 or another participating employer within five years, such member shall receive credit for such member's service prior to such termination. If the 41 member does not elect to leave the accumulated contributions on deposit 42 or if the member does not return to covered employment within five 43

years, such member shall no longer be a member of the system and the 1 2 sum of such member's accumulated contributions then on deposit with this system shall be paid to such member after making application in a 3 form prescribed by the board and after the system has a reasonable time to process the application for withdrawal. Upon proper notification by 5 the system, member contributions not on deposit with the system shall 6 7 be paid to the member by the participating employer.

(2) If, after termination and withdrawal of accumulated contribu-8 9 tions, a former member returns to covered employment, except as oth-10 erwise provided in subsection (1), the former member shall become a member of the system as provided in subsection (2) of K.S.A. 74-4955 11 and amendments thereto. Any former member returning to covered em-12 13 ployment may, at the former member's option, pay to the system within 14 31 days of the former member's return to covered employment, the total 15 of the former member's withdrawn accumulated contributions plus interest at a rate specified by the board, in which case the member shall 16 17 receive full credit for the member's service prior to the member's termination. Subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74 49,123 and 18 19 amendments thereto, members who do not elect to repay within 31 days 20 of return to covered employment may elect to purchase previously for 21 feited service any time prior to retirement. Such purchase shall be made 22 by a lump sum payment equal to 1.75% of the member's current annual 23 salary for each quarter of previously forfeited participating service which 24 the member elects to repurchase. purchase service credit for such pre-25 viously forfeited service credit, subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 26 Supp. 74-49,123, and amendments thereto, at an additional rate of con-27 tribution, in addition to the employee's rate of contribution as provided 28 in K.S.A. 74-4919, and amendments thereto, based upon the member's 29 attained age at the time of purchase and using actuarial assumptions and 30 tables in use by the retirement system at such time of purchase for such 31 periods of service. Such additional rate of contribution shall commence 32 at the beginning of the quarter following such election and shall remain in effect until all quarters of such service have been purchased. Subject 33 to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-49,123, and amendments 34 35 thereto, such member may elect to effect such purchase by means of a single lump-sum payment in lieu of the increased amount of the em-36 37 ployee's contribution rate otherwise provided for in this act in an amount equal to the then present value of the benefits being purchased determined 38 by the actuary using the member's attained age, annual compensation at 39 40 the time of purchase and the actuarial assumptions and tables then in use 41 by the retirement system. The lump-sum payment shall be made imme-42 diately upon being notified of the amount due. Upon receipt of such pay-43 ment by the system the member shall receive full credit for the number

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of previously forfeited quarters of participating service which the member
 has elected to repurchase. Any member who repurchases all of the mem ber's previously forfeited participating service credit shall also receive all
 of the member's previously forfeited prior service credit.

5 (3) Upon termination and withdrawal of accumulated contributions, 6 any member whose employment was, up to the member's employer's 7 entry date, covered by a pension system established under the provisions 8 of K.S.A. 13-14a01 through 13-14a14, and amendments thereto, or K.S.A. 9 14-10a01 through 14-10a15, and amendments thereto, shall be entitled 10 to receive from the member's employer the sum of the member's accu-11 mulated contributions to the previous pension system.

(4) If a member has completed 15 years of credited service at date 12 of termination, the member shall be granted automatically a vested re-13 tirement benefit in the system, but any time prior to the commencement 14 15 of retirement benefit payments and before attaining age 55 the member may withdraw the member's accumulated contributions, whereupon the 16 17 member's membership in this system ceases and no other amounts shall be payable for the member's prior and participating service credit. Eli-18 gibility of such member, who has not withdrawn the member's accumu-19 20 lated contributions, for retirement benefits and procedures for making 21 application for retirement benefits shall be in accordance with K.S.A. 74-4957 and amendments thereto, except that in lieu of the three-month 22 23 notice of intention to retire being made to the employer, such member shall make application for retirement in a form prescribed by the board 24 25 and retirement benefits shall accrue from the first day of the month fol-26 lowing receipt of such application. The amount of the retirement benefit shall be determined as provided in K.S.A. 74-4958 and amendments 27 28 thereto.

29 (5) If a member, who has a vested retirement benefit, again becomes 30 an employee of a participating employer, the amount of the member's 31 vested retirement benefit shall remain in effect, and any retirement ben-32 efit such member subsequently accrues shall be calculated separately based on credited service after again becoming an employee and shall be 33 added to that which had been vested by virtue of previous service. Eli-34 35 gibility of such member for retirement benefits and procedures for making application for retirement benefits shall be in accordance with K.S.A. 36 37 74-4957 and amendments thereto.

(6) Any member of this system who was previously a member of the
Kansas public employees retirement system or the retirement system for
judges and who forfeited service credit under either of those systems by
reason of termination of employment and withdrawal of their contributions to that system, may elect, subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 2000
Supp. 74-49,123 and amendments thereto, to purchase service credit for

1	the previously forfeited service credit by means of a single lump-sum
2	payment and such service shall be recredited to that system. The amount
3	of the lump-sum payment shall be determined by the actuary using the
4	member's then current annual rate of compensation and the actuarial
5	assumptions and tables then currently in use by that retirement system.
6	(7) The provisions of this section shall be effective on and after July
7	1, 1989 and shall apply only to members who were appointed or employed
8	prior to July 1, 1989, and who made an election pursuant to K.S.A. 74-
9	4955a and amendments thereto; and persons appointed or employed on
10	or after July 1, 1989.
11	Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-4963 and 74-4963a are hereby
12	repealed.
13	Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
14	publication in the statute book.
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
