AN ACT concerning animals; relating to the treatment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) When used in this section:

- (1) "Animal means any mammalian animal other than human and any fowl, bird, amphibian, fish or reptile, wild or domestic.
- (2) "Licensed veterinarian," "veterinarian," "graduate veterinary technician" and "registered veterinary technician" shall have the same meaning as is ascribed thereto by K.S.A. 47-816, and amendments thereto.
- (b) Whenever a licensed veterinarian, veterinarian, graduate veterinary technician, registered veterinary technician or other person under the supervision of any such person applies a cast to the broken or fractured bone of an animal, an x-ray shall be taken of the broken or fractured bone immediately after such cast is applied.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
