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## **HOUSE BILL No. 2559**

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8 9 AN ACT concerning the department of transportation; relating to rail-10 road assistance programs; amending K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 75-5048 and 11 repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 75-5048 is hereby amended to read as 15 follows: 75-5048. (a) The secretary of transportation is hereby authorized to make loans or grants to a qualified entity for the purpose of facilitating 16 17 the financing, acquisition or rehabilitation of railroads or railroad rolling 18 stock or equipment in the state of Kansas. 19 (b) Such loans or grants shall be made upon such terms and condi-20 tions as the secretary of transportation may deem appropriate, and such 21 loans or grants shall be made from funds credited to the rail service improvement fund. 22 23 (c) The rail service improvement fund is hereby established in the 24 state treasury which shall be for the purpose of facilitating the financing, 25 acquisition and rehabilitation of railroads or railroad rolling stock or 26 equipment pursuant to subsection (a) of this section and for the refinanc-27 ing thereof. The secretary of transportation shall administer the rail serv-28 ice improvement fund. All expenditures from the rail service improve-29 ment fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon 30 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouch-31 ers approved by the secretary of transportation or by a person or persons 32 designated by the secretary. 33 (d) All moneys received from the federal government under the local 34 rail freight assistance program (49 U.S.C. 1654) shall be remitted to the 35 state treasurer. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer 36 shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the

37 rail service improvement fund.

(e) The management and investment of the rail service improvement
fund shall be in accordance with K.S.A. 68-2324, and amendments
thereto. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, All interest or other
income of the investments, after payment of any management fees, shall
be considered income of the rail service improvement fund.

43 (f) (1) On July 1, 1999, and each July 1 thereafter, the director of

1	accounts and reports shall transfer \$3,000,000 from the state highway
2	fund to the rail service improvement fund.
3	(2) The provisions of this subsection shall expire on June 30, 2007.
4	(g) "Qualified entity" means any interstate commerce commission
5	certificated railroad, a port authority established in accordance with Kan-

6 sas laws, or any entity meeting the rules and regulations established by7 K.S.A. 75-5050, and amendments thereto.

8 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 75-5048 is hereby repealed.

9 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 10 publication in the statute book.
