AN ACT concerning public health and welfare; relating to the Kansas
children's cabinet and the sunflower foundation; prescribing certain
guidelines and conditions precedent for expenditures by the sunflower
foundation.

14 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. All expenditures by the "Sunflower Foundation: Health Care for Kansans," a not-for-profit corporation which was created pur-suant to the settlement agreement entered into by the parties and ap-proved by the court in the case of Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, Inc., vs. Carla Stovall, Kansas Attorney General, Case No. 97CV000608, Shawnee County District Court, and which is referred to in this act as the sunflower foundation, for purposes for which the moneys credited to the children's initiatives fund may be expended shall be subject to approval by the Kansas children's cabinet established by K.S.A. 38-1901 and amendments thereto. All such expenditures by the sunflower foundation shall be subject to and shall be made in accordance with the same guide-lines, conditions and restrictions prescribed by law for expenditures from the children's initiatives fund by subsection (b) of K.S.A. 38-2102 and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the Kansas register.
