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17 AN ACT relating to fetal alcohol syndrome; establishing a diagnostic and

19 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

20 Section 1. (a) Within the limits of the appropriations therefor, the
21 secretary of health and environment may establish not more than five
22 fetal alcohol syndrome diagnostic and prevention network pilot programs.
23 The pilot programs shall be established in ~~Emporia and in other locations~~
24 ~~throughout the state as determined by the secretary of health and envi-~~
25 ~~ronment~~ **communities which indicate availability of local funding,**
26 **in kind services, or other resources for a fetal alcohol syndrome**
27 **diagnostic and prevention pilot program.** The pilot programs shall
28 expire on July 1, 2004.

29 (b) The department of health and environment shall work with local
30 health agencies to determine the sites where the pilot programs will be
31 established and shall establish standards for the development of the pilot
32 programs and the collection of data by such programs. The secretary of
33 health and environment may enter into contracts as appropriate for the

6 uation of the pilot programs data relating to fetal alcohol syndrome as
7 developed by the pilot programs, specific recommendations with regard
8 to the programs and such other information and recommendations relat-
9 ing to the programs as the local health department deems appropriate.

10 (d) The provisions of this section shall expire on July 1, 2004.
