AN ACT concerning the flag of the United States of America; relating to the use and display thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The state board of education shall implement a program of instruction relating to the flag of the United States of America and to flag etiquette, use and display. Such course shall include the requirements contained in 36 U.S.C. §§ 170 through 177, as in effect on the effective date of this act. Such course may include other provisions deemed necessary by the board.

- (b) The state board of education shall adopt any rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of subsection (a).
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
