(a) The Kansas children's cabinet is hereby authorized to 21 negotiate and enter into an agreement with a not-for-profit foundation or other not-for-profit entity to receive, administer and invest any moneys 2223 donated, bequeathed, granted, awarded or contributed from any private or public source outside the state treasury for the general benefit of the 24 25 programs sponsored by the Kansas children's cabinet or for specific cap-26 ital improvements, projects, programs, activities or events for the benefit of the children of Kansas. All moneys received for such purposes by the 27 28 not-for-profit foundation or other entity, and all interest earned thereon, shall be deposited, administered and disbursed by the not-for-profit foun-29 30 dation or other entity to the Kansas children's cabinet in accordance with 31 the agreement, after payment of any applicable fees or expenses authorized by the agreement. The Kansas children's cabinet shall not enter into 32 any agreement with the not for profit foundation or other entity under 33 this section until the agreement has been reviewed and approved by the 34 attorney general. In addition to other duties under law, the attorney 35 general shall advise and serve as legal counsel for the Kansas chil-36 37 dren's cabinet with respect to all agreements entered into by the Kansas children's cabinet under this section. 38

(b) Upon receipt of any such moneys by the Kansas children's cabinet, the cabinet shall remit the entire amount of the remittance to the
state treasurer. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer
shall transfer such moneys to such funds, organizations or grantees as
specified by the Kansas children's cabinet.

Sec. 2. All expenditures by the "Sunflower Foundation: 1 2 Health Care for Kansans," a not-for-profit corporation which was created pursuant to the settlement agreement entered into by the 3 parties and approved by the court in the case of Blue Cross and 4 Blue Shield of Kansas, Inc., vs. Carla Stovall, Kansas Attorney Gen-5 eral, Case No. 97CV000608, Shawnee County District Court, and 6 which is referred to in this act as the sunflower foundation, for 7 8 purposes for which the moneys credited to the children's initiatives 9 fund may be expended shall be subject to approval by the Kansas 10 children's cabinet established by K.S.A. 38-1901 and amendments 11 thereto. All such expenditures by the sunflower foundation shall be subject to and shall be made in accordance with the same guide-12 lines, conditions and restrictions prescribed by law for expendi-13 tures from the children's initiatives fund by subsection (b) of K.S.A. 14 15 38-2102 and amendments thereto.

16 Sec. 3. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, all mem-17 bers of the board of trustees of the sunflower foundation shall be 18 appointed as prescribed by this section.

(b)(1) On or after the effective date of this act, upon the expi-19 20 ration of the term of office of the members of the board of trustees 21 of the sunflower foundation who were first-appointed and who 22 were appointed to a one-year term, successors shall be appointed 23 to such membership offices on the board of trustees for three-year 24 terms in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the con-25 stitution and bylaws of the sunflower foundation and the settle-26 ment agreement which prescribe the qualifications and composi-27 tion of the board of trustees, except that (A) one such office shall be filled by appointment by the governor from among the persons 28 nominated for the office by the community advisory committee as 29 30 provided in the settlement agreement, (B) one such office shall be 31 filled by appointment by the speaker of the house of representa-32 tives from among the persons nominated for the office by the com-33 munity advisory committee as provided in the settlement agreement, and (C) the remaining such office shall be filled by 34 35 appointment by the president of the senate from among the persons nominated for the office by the community advisory commit-36 37 tee as provided in the settlement agreement.

(2) On or after the effective date of this act, upon the expiration
of the term of office of the members of the board of trustees of
the sunflower foundation who were first-appointed and who were
appointed to a two-year term, successors shall be appointed to such
membership offices on the board of trustees for three-year terms
in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the constitution

and bylaws of the sunflower foundation and the settlement agree-1 2 ment which prescribe the qualifications and composition of the 3 board of trustees, except that (A) one such office shall be filled by appointment by the governor from among the persons nominated 4 for the office by the community advisory committee as provided 5 in the settlement agreement, (B) one such office shall be filled by 6 7 appointment by the minority leader of the house of representatives 8 from among the persons nominated for the office by the commu-9 nity advisory committee as provided in the settlement agreement, 10 and (C) the remaining such office shall be filled by appointment 11 by the minority leader of the senate from among the persons nominated for the office by the community advisory committee as pro-12 13 vided in the settlement agreement.

14 (3) On or after the effective date of this act, upon the expiration 15 of the term of office of the members of the board of trustees of the sunflower foundation who were first-appointed and who were 16 appointed to a three-year term, successors shall be appointed to 17 18 such membership offices on the board of trustees for three-year 19 terms in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the con-20 stitution and bylaws of the sunflower foundation and the settle-21 ment agreement which prescribe the qualifications and composi-22 tion of the board of trustees, except that, of such offices, (A) the 23 office of the member appointed by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of 24 Kansas, Inc., shall be filled by appointment by the governor from 25 among a list of three or more persons who shall be nominated for 26 the office by the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, Inc., (B) 27 one of the two remaining appointments for such offices shall be filled by appointment by the speaker of the house of representa-28 29 tives from among the persons nominated for the office by the com-30 munity advisory committee as provided in the settlement agree-31 ment, and (C) the last remaining appointment for such offices shall 32 be filled by appointment by the president of the senate from 33 among the persons nominated for the office by the community advisory committee as provided in the settlement agreement. 34

35 (c) In the case of a vacancy existing on or after the effective 36 date of this act in the office of any member of the board of trustees 37 of the sunflower foundation, the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment in accordance with and subject to 38 the provisions of the constitution and bylaws of the sunflower foun-39 40 dation and the settlement agreement which are applicable to the appointment of a member to the vacant office, except that such 41 42 vacancy shall be filled by appointment from among the persons 43 nominated for the office by the community advisory committee as provided in the settlement agreement by the officer who is speci fied by subsection (b) to appoint successors to the office of the
 member upon expiration of the term of such office.

4 (d) The provisions of this section shall not affect the office of 5 any member of the board of trustees of the sunflower foundation 6 who is appointed to such board of trustees prior to the effective 7 date of this act, except as specifically provided in any case of a 8 vacancy in such office existing on or after the effective date of this 9 act.

(e) As used in this section "settlement agreement" means the
settlement agreement entered into by the parties and approved by
the court in the case of Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas, Inc.,
vs. Carla Stovall, Attorney General, Case 97CV000608, Shawnee
County District Court.

15 Sec. 4. The sunflower foundation and the board of trustees of the sunflower foundation are hereby made subject to and shall 16 17 comply with the provisions of the professional services sunshine act, K.S.A. 75-37,130 through 75-37,135 and amendments thereto. 18 Sec. 5. If any provision or clause of this act or application 19 20 thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such inva-21 lidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or appli-22 23 cation, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be 24 severable.

Sec. 2. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book Kansas register.

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
