AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to the effective date of
transfers of territory; amending K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 72-7108 and re pealing the existing section.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 72-7108 is hereby amended to read as 14follows: 72-7108. Transfers of territory from one unified district to an-15other unified district shall be made only as follows: (a) Upon the written 16agreement of any two boards approved by the state board of education, 17or (b) upon order of the state board after petition therefor by one board 18and a public hearing thereon conducted by the state board of education. 19 Unless otherwise agreed to by the boards and approved by the state board 20of education, the effective date of any such transfer shall be the date of 21approval thereof or order therefor issued by the state board of education 22 23or the July 1 following the expiration of a 12-month period commencing on the date of the approval of the transfer or order therefor issued by the 24state board of education. Notice of the public hearing on such a petition 25shall be given by publication by the state board of education for two 26consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the unified 27district from which territory is to be transferred, the last publication to 2829be not more than 10 nor less than three days prior to the date of the hearing. The notice shall state the time and place of the hearing and shall 30 give a summary description of the territory proposed to be transferred. 31 Within 90 days after receiving an agreement or, if a public hearing is held, 32 within 90 days after the hearing, the state board of education shall issue 33 its order either approving or disapproving such transfer petition or agree-34 ment, or approving the same with such amendments as it deems appro-35 priate. Whenever a petition for transfer of territory has been denied by 36 the state board of education, no petition for transfer of substantially the 37 same territory shall be received or considered by the state board of ed-38 ucation for a period of two years. 39 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 72-7108 is hereby repealed. 40
