(a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, 15 the definitions set forth in K.S.A. 25-4143, and amendments thereto, shall be applicable to the provisions in this section. 16 17 (2) As used in this section "regulated entity" means any person who is required by law to be licensed by the insurance commissioner, or any 18 person who engages in a business or profession which is regulated by the 19 20 insurance commissioner, or any person employed by a company regulated 21 by the insurance commissioner. (b) No regulated entity and no person or political committee acting 22 23 on behalf of a regulated entity shall make a contribution to or on behalf 24 of a person holding the office of insurance commissioner, to or on behalf 25 of a candidate for the office of insurance commissioner or, to or on behalf 26 of a candidate committee of any such candidate. 27 No person holding the office of insurance commissioner shall (c) 28 knowingly solicit or accept any contribution from any regulated entity or any person or political committee acting on behalf of such regulated 29 30 entity. 31 (d) No candidate for the office of insurance commissioner shall know-32 ingly solicit or accept any contribution from any regulated entity or any 33 person or political committee acting on behalf of such regulated entity. (e) No candidate committee of a candidate for the office of insurance 34 35 commissioner shall knowingly solicit or accept any contribution from any regulated entity or any person or political committee acting on behalf of 36 37 such regulated entity. (f) Any person or entity violating the provisions of this act shall be 38 punished in the manner and be subject to the penalties prescribed by 39 40 K.S.A. 25-4181. and amendments thereto. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 41 42 publication in the statute book.
