9 AN ACT concerning tourism; establishing a state tourism advertising
 10 fund.

12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury the 13 Kansas tourism advertising fund. All moneys credited to such fund shall 14 be used only for the purpose of advertising Kansas tourism opportunities 15 to potential tourists both within and outside of the state. Such fund shall 16 be administered in accordance with this section and the provisions of 17 appropriation acts. All expenditures from the fund shall be made in ac-18 cordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of ac-19 counts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary 20 of commerce and housing or the secretary's designee. 21

(b) For the taxable year ending December 31, 2001, and in all taxable 22 years thereafter, the secretary of revenue shall identify all taxpayers iden-23 tified by standard industrial classification code numbers 5812, 5813, 7011 24 and 7033 or the corresponding north american industrial classification 25 26 code if appropriate and shall determine aggregate amount of tax revenues paid by such taxpayers pursuant to K.S.A. 79-3601 et seq. and amend-27 ments thereto. For the taxable year ending December 31, 2002, and for 28 all taxable years thereafter, the secretary of revenue shall determine an 29 amount, if any, by which such revenues have increased over the preceding 30 taxable year. The secretary shall then certify an amount to the director of 31 accounts and reports equal to 50% of the amount by which such revenues 32 have increased in excess of 3% above the previous taxable year. 33

(c) On July 1, 2003, and annually on July 1 of each year thereafter or
as soon thereafter as sufficient moneys are available, the secretary of
accounts and reports shall transfer such certified amount from the state
general fund to the credit of the state tourism advertising fund.
