Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "motor-vehicle fuels" has the meaning provided by K.S.A. 79-3401, and amendments thereto. (b) Not less than 80% by volume of all **All bulk** motor-vehicle fuels purchased by any state agency, as defined in K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto, in each fiscal year for use in state-owned motor vehicles in the state central motor pool and branches of the state central motor-pool shall be motor-vehicle fuel blends containing at least 10% ethanol. However, such state agencies shall not be required to purchase bulk motor-vehicle fuel blends containing at least 10% etha-nol, if the cost of such fuel exceeds the cost of regular unleaded gasoline by \$.10 per gallon. (c) Where available under current state purchasing agreements, individual motor-vehicle fuel purchases for state-owned motor vehicles shall be of motor-vehicle fuel blends containing at least 10% ethanol. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
