SENATE BILL No. 314

9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas highway patrol; relating to restrictions
10 on certain political activity; amending K.S.A. 74-2113 and repealing
11 the existing section.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 74-2113 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-14 15 2113. (a) There is hereby created a Kansas highway patrol. The patrol shall consist of: (1) A superintendent, who shall have the rank of colonel 16 17 and who shall have special training and qualifications for such position; 18 (2) an assistant superintendent, who shall have the rank of lieutenant colonel; and (3) officers and troopers who are appointed in accordance 19 20 with appropriation acts and as provided in this section. The superinten-21 dent and assistant superintendent shall be within the unclassified service under the Kansas civil service act. The assistant superintendent serving 22 23 on the effective date of this act shall be appointed to such position by the superintendent. Thereafter, the assistant superintendent shall be ap-24 25 pointed by the superintendent from among the members of the patrol, 26 and shall serve at the pleasure of the superintendent. If a person ap-27 pointed as superintendent or assistant superintendent is a member of the 28 patrol when appointed, such person in each case, upon termination of the 29 term as superintendent or assistant superintendent, respectively, shall be 30 returned to a rank not lower than the rank such person held when ap-31 pointed as superintendent or assistant superintendent. If such rank is 32 filled at that time, a temporary additional position shall be created in such rank until a vacancy occurs in such rank. All other officers, troopers and 33 employees shall be within the classified service under the Kansas civil 34 35 service act.

(b) The superintendent of the patrol shall be appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 754315b, and amendments thereto, and shall receive an annual salary fixed
by the governor. The assistant superintendent shall receive an annual
salary fixed by the superintendent and approved by the governor.

41 (c) All other members of the patrol shall be appointed by the super42 intendent in accordance with appropriation acts and with the Kansas civil
43 service act. No person shall be appointed as an officer of the patrol, other

than superintendent, unless the person has had at least five years of serv-1 2 ice in the patrol as an officer or trooper. No person shall be appointed as a trooper unless the person meets the following requirements: 3

- (1) Is a citizen of the United States;
- (2)is at least 21 years of age at the time of appointment;

has not been convicted by any state or the federal government of 6 (3) 7 a crime which is a felony or its equivalent under the uniform code of 8 military justice;

9 (4) has been fingerprinted and a search of local, state and national 10 fingerprint files has been made to determine whether the applicant has 11 a criminal record;

(5) is the holder of a high school diploma or furnishes evidence of 12 13 successful completion of an examination indicating an equivalent achieve-14 ment; and

15 (6) is free of any physical or mental condition which might adversely affect the applicant's performance of duties as a trooper and whose phys-16 ical health has been certified by an examining physician appointed by the 17 18 superintendent.

(d) No member of the patrol shall hold any other elective or appoint-19 20 ive commission or office, except in the Kansas national guard or in the 21 organized reserve of the United States army, air force or navy. No member of the patrol shall accept any employment or compensation from any 22 23 licensee of the director of alcoholic beverage control of the department 24 of revenue or from any licensee of the Kansas racing commission or from any officer, director, member or employee of any such licensee, nor shall 25 26 any member of the patrol accept any employment or compensation for 27 services which require the use of any state-owned equipment provided by the Kansas highway patrol or the wearing of the patrol uniform. No 28 member of the patrol shall accept any reward or gift except with the 29 30 written permission of the superintendent.

(e) No member of the patrol, including the superintendent, shall in 31 32 any way be active or participate in any political contest in any primary, general or special election or participate in politics, except to cast such 33 member's ballot. For any violation of this provision, the offender shall be 34 35 summarily removed by the superintendent from the patrol.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-2113 is hereby repealed. 36

37 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book. 38
