AN ACT concerning local units of government; relating to minimum codes for cities and counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c), on and after July 1, 2001, any city or county which adopts a building code shall adopt the following:

- (1) The international building code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- (2) the international residential code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- (3) the international fuel gas code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- $\left(4\right)$ $\,$ the international fire code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- (5) the international mechanical code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- (6) the international plumbing code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- (7) the international sewage disposal code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
- (8) the international property maintenance code, 2000 edition, as published by the international code council;
 - (9) the uniform code for building conservation; and
 - (10) the national electric code, 1999 edition.
- (b) Any city or county which adopted a building code prior to July 1, 2001, may continue to enforce such building code. Whenever any city or county amends such current building code, such amendment shall include adoption of the codes listed in subsection (a).
- (c) Any city or county may adopt a building code, or component thereof, which is more stringent than the codes listed in subsection (a).
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
