8 9 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to lease and lease-purchase 10 agreements entered into by boards of education; amending K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 72-8225 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 72-8225 is hereby amended to read as 14 15 follows: 72-8225. The board of education of any school district, as lessee or lessor, may enter into written contracts for the use of real or personal 16 17 property and, in addition to the foregoing, the board of education of any school district may enter into lease-purchase agreements as provided by 18 K.S.A. 10-1116b, and amendments thereto. No board of education shall 19 20 enter into any contract under authority of this section as lessor of any 21 school bus, as defined in K.S.A. 72-8301, and amendments thereto. The term of Any lease or lease-purchase agreement entered into under au-22 23 thority of this section by a board of education as lessee may be for a term 24 not to exceed 10 years. Such Any lease or lease-purchase agreement en-25 tered into under authority of this section by a board of education as lessor 26 may be for any term of years that the board determines is in the best 27 interest of the school district. Any lease or lease-purchase agreement en-28 tered into under authority of this section may provide for annual or other payment of rent or rental fees and may obligate the school district to 29 30 payment of maintenance or other expenses. The provisions of the cash 31 basis law shall not apply to any lease or lease-purchase agreement entered 32 into under authority of this section in such a manner as to prevent the intention of this section from being made effective. Any lease-purchase 33 agreement which is entered into under authority of this section by any 34 35 school district and which involves the acquisition of land or buildings is subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-1116c, and amendments thereto. 36 37 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 72-8225 is hereby repealed. 38 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its Sec. 3. publication in the statute book.
