AN ACT concerning electronic transactions; establishing the electronic transactions registration fee fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury the electronic transactions registration fee fund. All moneys credited to the electronic transactions registration fee fund shall be used for the expenses incurred for the performance of the duties and functions of the secretary of state under the uniform electronic transactions act. All expenditures from the electronic transactions registration fee fund shall be made in accordance with the provisions of appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary of state or by a person or persons designated by the secretary. Registration fees and other moneys received under this act by the secretary of state shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the electronic transactions registration fee fund.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
