Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "biodiesel" means mono-alkyl esters derived from vegetable oil or animal fat, as defined by the American Society of Testing and Materials (ASTM) Provisional Specification 121 (PS 121). (b) Not less than 80% by volume of all **All bulk** diesel fuels purchased by any state agency, as defined by K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto, in each fiscal year for use in state-owned motor vehicles in the state central motor pool and branches of the state central motor pool shall be diesel fuel blends containing at least 2% biodiesel. However, such state agencies shall not be required to purchase bulk diesel fuel containing at least 2% biodiesel, if the cost of such fuel exceeds the cost of regular diesel fuel by \$.10 per gallon. (c) Where available under current state purchasing agreements, individual diesel fuel purchases for state-owned motor vehicles shall be of diesel fuel blends containing at least 2% biodiesel. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
